USE OF STUDENT IMAGES

At **St. Olave's Grammar School** we take the issue of child safety very seriously, and this includes the use of images of pupils. Including images of students in school publications and on the school website can be motivating for the students involved, and provides a good opportunity to promote the work of the school. In addition digital video is an exciting new medium which can motivate and inspire students. However, schools have a duty of care towards their students, which means that pupils must remain unidentifiable, reducing the risk of inappropriate contact, if images are used in this way.

In line with General Data Protection Regulation, and the school's policy on Data Protection, we ask that parents/carers consent to the school taking and using photographs and images, including digital video work, of their children. We will never include the full name of the student alongside an image, which is circulated externally, except in the following circumstance:

There are occasions where it is appropriate to print student names on printed documents. Personal
details or full names will only be included in external publications (including on line) in exceptional
circumstances, or specifically requested by a data subject or their parent/carer.
