History visit to Chatham Dockyard, Tuesday 15th July 2014

A visit has been organised for Year 9 students to Chatham Dockyard on Tuesday 15th July during Activities Week 2. The students will have a guided tour of the dockyard which will include exploring a Victorian sloop, a World War Two destroyer and a Cold War submarine. The boys have studied World War Two and the beginning of the Cold War in History lessons this year and so visiting such an important former naval base will be of particular interest to them.

Pupils will need to wear full school uniform and bring a packed lunch. They should bring a raincoat in case of bad weather. They should arrive at the school no later than 8:30am and the coaches will return at approximately 3:30pm to the Goddington Lane entrance.

A voluntary contribution of £17 is requested towards the cost of the visit. If we do not receive enough voluntary contributions to make the educational visit possible other sources of funding are not available and, as such, we may be forced to cancel the visit.
