

SUBJECT-BASED CLUBS AND SOCIETIES

There are numerous subject-based clubs and societies as well as the popular debating and language clubs. For many years groups have been involved in World Challenge Expeditions which in recent years have travelled to Tanzania, Peru, Costa Rica and Morocco where they enjoyed a combination of mountain trekking and project work in local schools. Recently groups have also taken part in Operation Wallacea, which involved conservation work in the game reserves of South Africa. The Duke of Edinburgh's Award Scheme is also very popular and offers Bronze, Silver and Gold Awards.

Students may opt for Community Service work on Wednesday afternoons through the School's 'Le Chavetois Society' which raises money and carries out voluntary work in the local community.

Each December the Sixth Form raises several thousand pounds (over 10,000 last year) for nominated charities during the annual "Festival Week" operated entirely within the school.
