Physical geography in my life



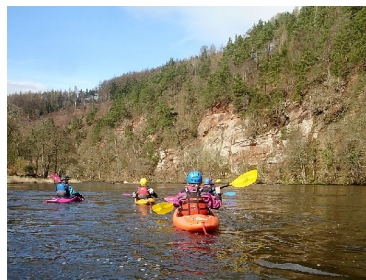
This year's competition is about capturing an aspect of physical geography and explaining how it links to your life.

The competition is open to any school pupil in Years 7-13 during the academic year 2017-18; there are two age-related categories Y7-9 and Y10-13.



Entries will be judged on both the photograph and your description.
