The Road Safety Team at the London Borough of Bromley has provisionally booked Cycle Training Courses for students at St Olave's School on the week commencing 18th February 2019 (during half term).

Please note your child must be able to ride a bicycle in order to take part in these courses.

Bikeability courses are designed to train children to cycle on the road safely and with confidence, so that they can go on to make independent on-road journeys.

We are offering 2 types of course, depending on your child's current cycling achievements:

- i) **Bikeability levels 1 and 2 Course:** Open to anyone who has not previously achieved Levels 1 & 2.
- ii) **Bikeability level 3 Course:** Children must have already passed Level 1& 2 in order to apply for this course.

A risk assessment has been made and fluorescent tabards will be worn by the cyclists. As this is a holiday course, the children are to wear **THEIR OWN CLOTHES**. Badges will be awarded to those that reach the required Bikeability standard.

Spaces are limited and allocated on a first come first serve basis.
